

FAQs

Q1: Who is responsible for compiling the list of the Laptop Scheme?

Answer: The Higher Education Commission (HEC) is compiling the list of students.

Q2: When will the distribution of laptops begin?

Answer: Presently, there is no finalized date for distribution. Rest assured, the university will inform all students once it is scheduled to commence.

Q3: How can students correct their data?

Answer: Students can make necessary corrections to their data by visiting the focal person's office, located at the Student Facilitation Center. This option will remain available until HEC authorizes the university to do so.

Q4: Which documents are required for the correction process?

Answer: For the correction process, the student must possess their CNIC number and relevant records, such as the result intimation of Fall 2022 and HSSC result. Additionally, first-semester students should provide their last degree result.

Q5: Can someone else make corrections on behalf of the student?

Answer: Yes, absolutely! If the designated person possesses all the necessary records mentioned in Answer 4, they are authorized to make corrections on behalf of the student.

Q6: What is the difference between "selected," "not selected," and "waiting" candidates?

Answer: "Selected" refers to students who have been chosen to receive a laptop. On the other hand, "not selected" implies that the student is ineligible for this scheme due to low CGPA. "Waiting" indicates that the student is eligible, but their merit position is relatively lower.

Q7: Will waiting candidates receive laptops in next stages?

Answer: Decisions regarding waiting candidates depend on the HEC and are contingent upon laptop availability.

Q8: My listed percentage differs from the one on my university-issued result intimation. Why is this so?

Answer: The percentage mentioned on the list represents the HSSC percentage.

Q9: Will students be selected based on their CGPA or percentage?

Answer: Selection will primarily be based on the CGPA. In cases where CGPA ties occur, preference will be given to students with a higher HSSC percentage.

Q10: I was initially selected in the first provisional list, but my name is now on the waiting in the second list. Why did this change happen?

Answer: Some students had inaccurately provided information about their CGPA, year of study, department, or degree program. As a result, after data correction, the positions on the merit list were affected.

Q11: Are students included in the provisional list guaranteed to receive a laptop?

Answer: No, the provisional list is not the final selection. Only students displayed in the final merit list will be eligible to receive laptops.

Q12: Can I apply for the laptop scheme now if I hadn't applied before?

Answer: Unfortunately, the online portal for applications was locked on 20-06-2023. Therefore, new applications cannot be accepted at this time.

Q13: My status is showing disapproved but I was verified earlier. Why did this change happen?

Answer: HEC has disapproved all those students who received laptop earlier from any of the government scheme.
