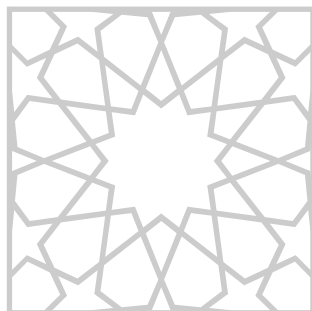




I N S I G H T S

﴿بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ﴾

IN THE NAME OF ALLĀH,

﴿لَا يَنْهَى اللَّهُ عَنِ الَّذِينَ لَمْ يُقَاتِلُوكُمْ فِي الدِّينِ وَلَمْ يُخْرِجُوا مِنْ دِيَارِهِمْ أَنْ تَرْوَهُمْ وَتُقْسِطُوا إِلَيْهِمْ إِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ الْمُقْسِطِينَ﴾

Allah does not forbid you to be kind and equitable to those who have neither fought you on account of *Dīn* (way of life) and nor driven you out from your homes, that you show them kindness and deal justly with them. Lo! Allah loves the ones who are just.

﴿إِنَّمَا يَنْهَى اللَّهُ عَنِ الَّذِينَ قَاتَلُوكُمْ فِي الدِّينِ وَأَخْرَجُواكُمْ مِنْ دِيَارِهِمْ وَظَاهَرُوا عَلَى إِخْرَاجِكُمْ أَنْ تَوَلَّوْهُمْ وَمَنْ يَتَوَلَّهُمْ فَآوَلَ يُلَاقِهِمُ اللَّهُمُ﴾

Verily Allah only forbids you from those who have fought against you on account of *Dīn* (way of life) and have driven you out from your homes and helped to drive you out, that you develop intimate-relationship with them. Whosoever develops intimate-relationship with them such are the wrong doers.
