- At the beginning of every month one reading unit and its question paper is sent to every candidate. The candidates are required to return the solved question papers within thirty days.
- The candidates securing an aggregate of at least 60% marks are awarded certificates of successful completion of the respective course.
- The reading Units explain the Basic Beliefs and Practical Teachings of Islam in the light of the Qur’ān and *Sunnah* avoiding the sectarian differences and prejudices.
- The standards of modern scholarship, and latest developments in various branches of knowledge are taken into consideration in preparation of the Units of these Courses.
- Children’s *Guldastah* Course is available only in Pakistan and its Annual Fee is only Rs. 300.00.
- Annual Fee (including the postal charges) for the rest of the courses is Rs. 500.00 (in Pakistan) and Rs. 3000.00 (abroad).

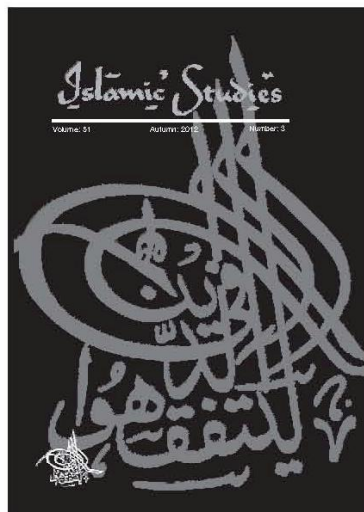

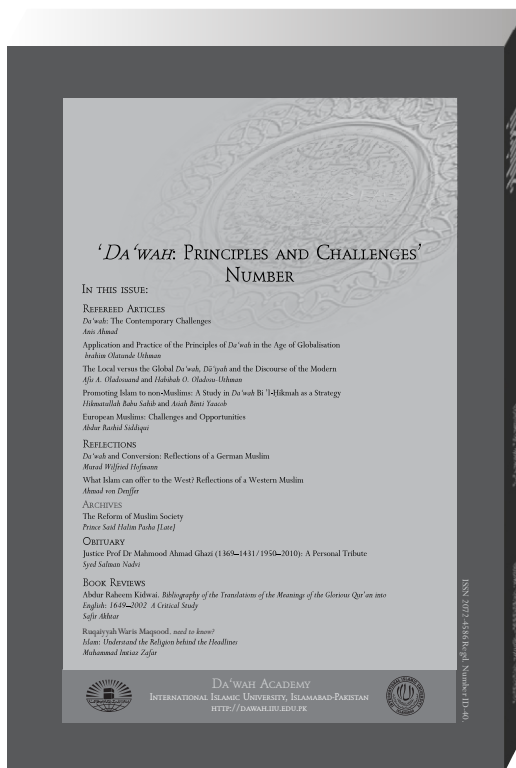




Da‘wah Principles and Challenges Number
